Girls will have a ton of fun in workshops they have chosen, earn Girl Scout badges/ patches all while making new friends and experiencing our twilight camp traditions!

Our Twilight Camp is an event hosted by the Colony Creek Girl Scout Community and planned for the late afternoon/evening to provide working parents an opportunity to volunteer with the event. The operation of this event is 100% dependent upon VOLUNTEER personnel. It cannot happen without parent participation. It's the perfect time for parents to support their daughter as she builds Courage, Confidence, and Character to make the world a better place!

CAMP COLONY CREEK AT A GLANCE

Girl Scout Daisies work on a patch program designed just for them. Girl Scout Brownies, Juniors, and Cadettes have an opportunity to choose their preferred workshops. Each workshop offers fun requirements for campers to earn a Girl Scout level badge or patch.

Girl Scout levels at Camp Colony Creek 2025:
Daisy (rising 1st graders), Brownie (rising 2nd/3rd graders), Junior (rising 4th/5th graders) and Cadette (rising 6th/7th/8th graders).

Program Aides are Girl Scout Cadettes going into 8th grade who assist Older Girl Workshop Leaders and/or Adult Workshop Leaders with various camp workshops. Our 'OWLs' (Older Girl Workshop Leaders) are Girl Scout Seniors and Ambassadors, who volunteer as workshop leaders to help younger girls earn badges. Adult volunteers serve as Cadette workshop leaders, program 'experts', safety help, first aiders, room monitors and as members of the Camp Core Committee which plans, organizes, prepares for months to bring the 3-day camp to life.

NEW / FORMER If you or your camper is not a current member of Girl Scouts, please register her online (gssjc.org). GIRL SCOUTS: Follow the steps described on Page 2 of this packet.

PLACEMENT: Campers are placed in groups based on their Girl Scout level, and in order of the following priority:

1. Girl Scouts accompanied by an adult volunteering all 3 days — Please volunteer!

All remaining Girl Scouts with accurate and complete camper registrations.
 Maximum registration of 300 Campers and Program Aides.

*What is a TAG? The term TAG is short for 'tag-a-long.' All non-Girl Scout children of camp volunteers are called "TAGs" All TAGs must be 3 years old. Girls, rising-K and younger. Boys, rising-4th graders and younger. See page 2 of this packet for more information about TAGs.

CONFIRMATION: Confirmation of registration will be emailed when registration is determined complete. Notice of an incomplete registration will be sent by email. Additional messages with camp information (emergency contact info, camper attire, supplies, and drop off/pick-up information) will be sent by email closer to the start of camp.

REFUNDS: All fees except \$20.00 are refunded after camp ends provided the Director receives written cancellation

prior to Saturday, June 1, 2025.

HOW TO REGISTER: Start by visiting our Camp Colony Creek 2025 website and sign-in: campcolonycreek.com

The Sign-Up an Adult Volunteer option provides information (t-shirt sizes, contact information, etc.) which helps in pre-camp preparation. Please help us by providing the same information on the Adult Volunteer Registration form and indicating your method of payment. This helps us organize data and create reports.

New! This year, your completed and signed forms may be submitted on our camp website. Here's how: Download the Adult Volunteer forms packet. Complete the forms. Save to your computer. Upload them to our website. -- OR -- you may save them on your computer, print them out and mail or deliver them to the address below by the April 30 deadline

-- OR -- Print the blank forms, complete them by hand, and mail or deliver them to the address below.

Camper, PA/OWL and adult registrations must be RECEIVED by April 30. Registration is complete when ALL required paperwork and fees have been received.

Additional postage may be required for a timely delivery!

DEADLINE:

Registrations should be received by Wednesday, April 30, 2025 to allow time for the camp staff to plan and prepare for the camp.

NEW OR FORMER GIRL SCOUTS:

If you are not a current member of Girl Scouts USA, please register Online (gssjc.org).

Parents with an already registered girl member should go to gssjc.org to access their GSUSA family account (linked to your daughter's registration). Register as a 'Friends and Family' volunteer member in your daughter's troop.

Adults who do not have a family account linked to a registered girl, should follow the prompts to 'Volunteer with Us'/'Get Started' > 'Sign Me Up' > Join as an Adult' on our council's website (gssjc.org) and continue the GSUSA-registration process. When asked to choose a troop, look for and choose 'Troop157NeedsPlacement'. Complete the registration process and payment.

Please note: The current adult membership fee for the remainder of the 2025 year, ending 9/30/2025, is \$25.00. The annual GSUSA fee for the 2026 membership year for adults will increase to \$30.00. As of April 1, 2025, an extended adult membership option will be offered for 18 months of GSUSA membership, ending 9/30/2026, for \$42.00. This is an option for 1st time members joining during the summer months. Forward the confirmation email received following completion of GSUSA-registration to our camp

- MORE ABOUT 'TAGS': 1 Our TAG care is not a camp program it is child care.
 - 2 TAGs may attend only when their camp-volunteer parent is at camp.
 - 3 All TAGs must be 3 years old and potty-trained. Girls, rising-K and younger. Boys, rising-4th graders and
 - 4 TAGs should be registered using the CAMPER REGISTRATION PACKET. Each TAG requires their own Permission Slip and Medical Information forms, complete with immunization and insurance card info.
 - 5 There is an \$10 per child, per day fee. The fee covers activity supplies and a 2024 camp patch.
 - 6 Camp t-shirts are optional, ordered on the Camper Registration form.
